PHOENIX SCHOOL - ANNUAL REPORT 2019 – 2020

During the year, 21 new children took admission in the school. The total number of children in the school was 100. The school had 14 full time academic teachers, 2 part time activity teachers and 5 helpers.

Results :-

- NIOS Results – 3 children cleared Data Entry, 3 - Home Science, Devika Hage - cleared Marathi & Business studies. All her papers are now cleared - so she has completed her NIOS Xth Std Board Exam. Rushikesh Kharabe - cleared Home Science.
- SSC - All the three students who appeared for the SSC Board Exam in March 2019, cleared all their papers. Raghav Bhamburkar - 57%, Rutuja Magar - 48%, Gayatri Kale - 40%.
- Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeth – 3 children appeared for the Marathi Uchha Stariya Pariksha -2nd exam. - Parth Marne is the topper with 75%, Shreyansh Wani scored 74% and Om Shimpi 53%.
3 children appeared for the Nimna Stariya Exam - Nandan Deshpande is the top scorer with 69. Shravani Kadekar scored 55 and Sanika Gade scored 53.
